OCI CHEMICAL CORPORATION RELOCATES TO MARIETTA, GEORGIA

May 21, 2007 – OCI Chemical announced to its employees on Friday, May 18, that its headquarters in Shelton, Conn., will relocate to Columbian's Headquarters and Technology Center in Marietta, Ga. Columbian and OCI are sister companies under the parent company, DC Chemical Co. Ltd. (DCC).

WooSug (Greg) Baik, President & CEO of DC Chemical, stated in his personal message to employees that *"One of DC Chemical's key strategies going forward is to reinforce its commitment to its two North American operations -- OCI and Columbian."*

The OCI Chemical headquarters organization in Shelton will move in its entirety to Marietta, with the relocation expected to be completed by early August. Columbian and OCI Chemical are separate businesses and will remain separate legal entities. Co-locating the two division headquarters in the same complex will reinforce DCC's long-term commitment to providing superior services to all customers and employees of both organizations. Co-locating will also improve dissemination of best practices between functional departments and facilitate common platforms for better efficiency and services.

Relocating OCI's headquarters to Marietta, Georgia, is expected to be seamless to all of our valued customers.
